

School Safety Closure or Delay Start information

Parents and guardians, school safety is a top priority in the KPBSD. It's important for you to know what to do before, during, and after a school emergency, weather related delay start, or school closure. If school remains open due to adverse weather, and you as a parent or guardian assess the conditions in your local area and decide to keep children home, please call the school to let the office know. An absence due to road and weather conditions will be excused.

STUDENT FEE PAYMENT OPTIONS

All new class fees will be assessed and available for payment on **January 22, 2018** through Power School. These fees may be paid using a credit or debit card. Athletic fees will be assessed when the athlete has made the team and may be paid after they show in PowerSchool. We encourage parents to use this new handy payment system. There is a 3.61% convenience fee assessed with each transaction. Payments will still be accepted at school if you choose to pay with cash or a check. Bring those types of payments to Mrs. Epperheimer in the front office.
