Administrators Reports

1. **MAPS** – (attachments). Handouts were provided to parents at conferences and will be in November newsletter. They explain how MAPS differs from Peaks and is adaptive. Also shows general overview of data (macro) and subject specific data (micro). MAPS will provide teachers with information to provide personalized learning for kids – what skills need worked on for them to get to average or above average. New for KCHS. Will be honing in on kids with below grade level and have risk factors in place in an effort to address social and emotional learning needs and build relationships. Data is available to parents upon request about their children. Will be even more useful after next testing round because will have comparative data. Next testing is second week of January.
2. **Sports** –
 - a. Rally In The Valley – Football varsity cheerleaders won, which was a huge accomplishment for a new program against many Anchorage area teams.
 - b. Swimming – They went to state and the highest finish was the 200m boys medley in 4th place. Six KCHS students competed at state. They won regional title and Winter Heaven coach of the year. The KCHS hosted meet went off without a hitch.
 - c. Wrestling, Skiing, Hockey – All going very well, are off and running. New coaches for wrestling and hockey.
 - d. Volleyball – 2nd place at regions. Going to state for first time in fourteen years next week. Coach Tracie Beck named coach of the year.
 - e. Honor Choir & Band – 11/21 through 11/23 is All State in Anchorage.
 - f. Football – Asked to drop down a level due to number of injuries and enrollment numbers support the request.
3. **10/18 Personalized Learning Professional Development** – Two facilitators came and helped. It was very productive. Got good feedback and are scheduling learning walks. PLT will meet on 11/14 to finalize scheduled.
4. **10/29 ALICE Drill** – ALICE drill was very successful. Evacuated to KMS for first time. Officer Prins and KFD gave great feedback.
5. **10/30 PSAT** – Fifty two students attended. It was a good turnout.
